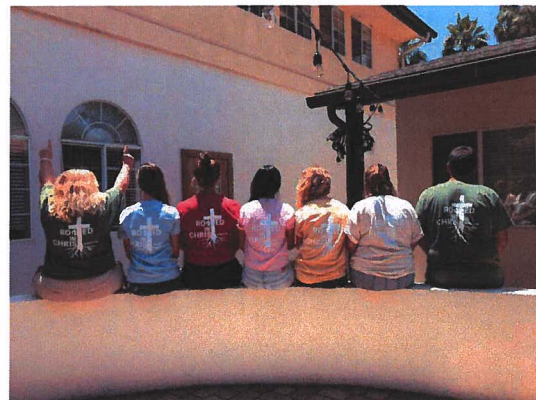

Throughout the school, he was frustrated with the staff for bringing him correction and always challenging him. This student kept going to other people here at YWAM LA for encouragement and didn't feel like our school staff was being loving enough towards him. Well, at the end of the school during the debriefing period, he shared that in the last bit of the school, he went to the same person he usually went to for kind, encouraging words. But in that moment, he realized that it wasn't what he actually needed. He said that he realized that he needed the correction and challenges the Bible school staff had been giving him all along. Although it wasn't always fun being challenged, he finally saw the value of it. Receiving encouragement can sometimes be the most loving thing, but at times, it is correction and being challenged that is even more loving.

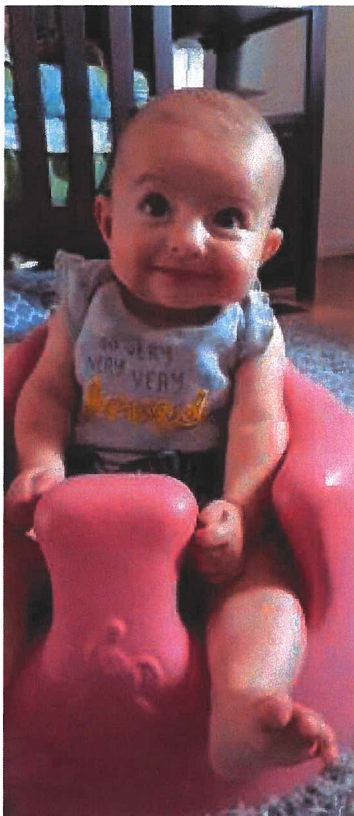
