Calvary Chapel: A Brief History

Calvary Chapel began in the late 1960’s with Pastor Chuck Smith and 25 church members. His teachings emphasized the Word of God and its application in people’s lives. Explosive growth in the church happened as a result of Pastor Chuck’s decision to minister to the “hippies” at the beaches of southern California. These people experienced radical transformations and turned to Jesus. As the Lord worked in their lives, they began to share the Good News. The fire spread! Today, there are Calvary Chapels all over the world!



Children’s Ministries:

Infants—4 years old: Parents leave their children in age appropriate classes downstairs. Children are to be signed in and signed out.

Kindergarten—3rd grade: Children meet in the Kindergarten Room for Worship at 10:30 am. They need to be signed in and out of class.

4th-5th grade: Children remain with their parents until they are dismissed after Worship. Teachers dismiss the them at the end of service.

Jr. High & High School Youth:

Our Jr. High Youth Group is led by Jason and Molly Cameron. High School Youth Group leaders are Thomas and Kaitlyn Salado-Poor. These groups meet on Sundays during Second Service and on Wednesdays at 6:00 pm. The High School Youth stay in the service on the last Sunday of the month.

Made in His Image (MIHI):

This class is for adults with disabilities. It meets on Sunday morning at 10:30 AM in Pastor Miles’ Office.
